Note: Some introductory courses at UPEI have high school prerequisites: Biology 1310 does not require grade 11 or 12 biology, but both are encouraged; Chemistry 1110 requires at least academic grade 12 chemistry; Physics 1110 does not require grade 11 or 12 physics, but both are encouraged; Math 1910 requires at least academic grade 12 math.

Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM)

The four-year Doctor of Veterinary Medicine program prepares students to work as veterinarians in private practice, academia, research, industry, and public service. A veterinary education on Prince Edward Island gives you direct access to unique study environments and animal species. Learn about and work with farm animals, horses, aquatic species, domestic and exotic pets, wildlife, and others in our beautiful island setting! Applicants must have at least 20 undergraduate credits in order to apply for this program.


